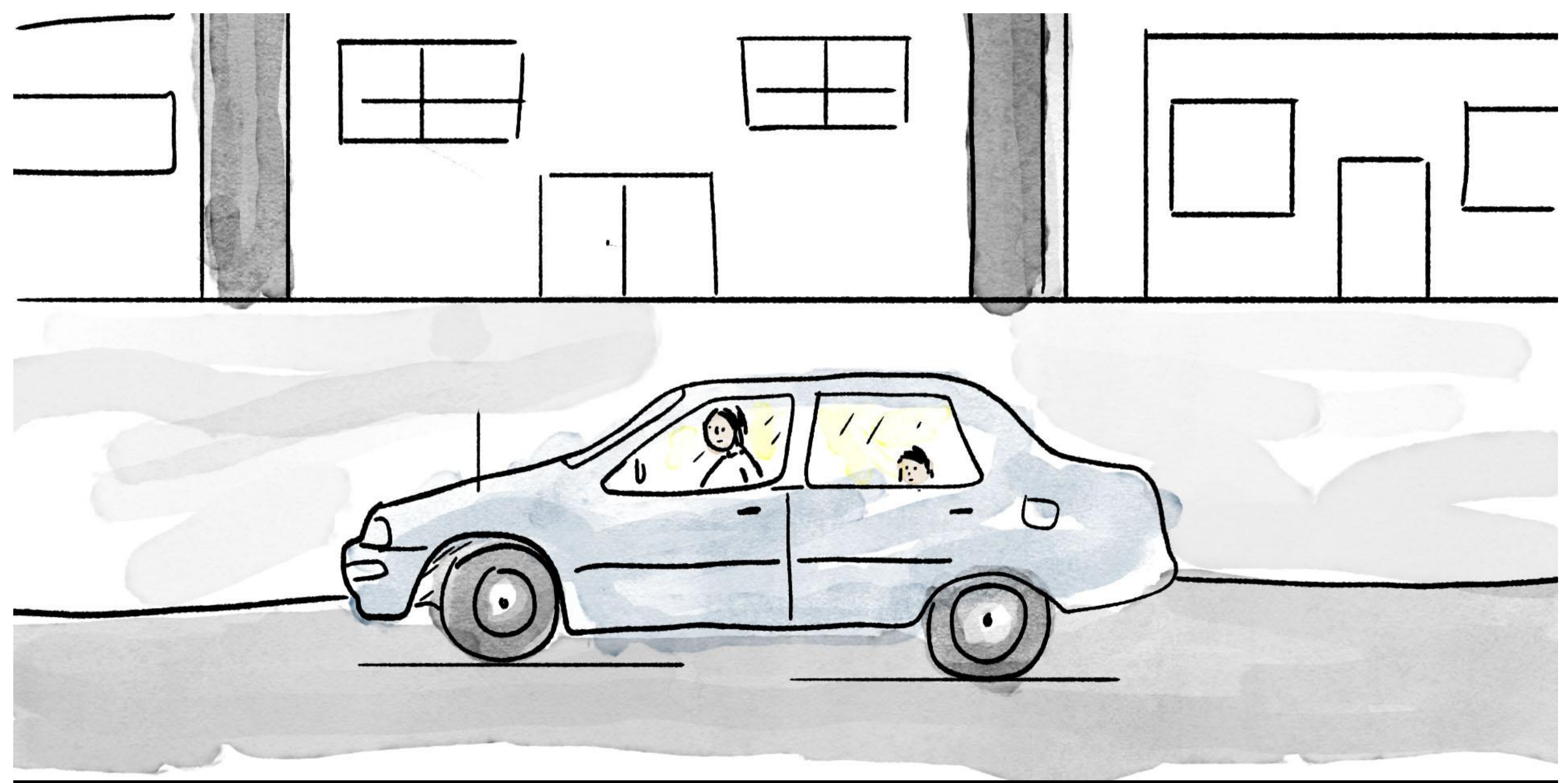




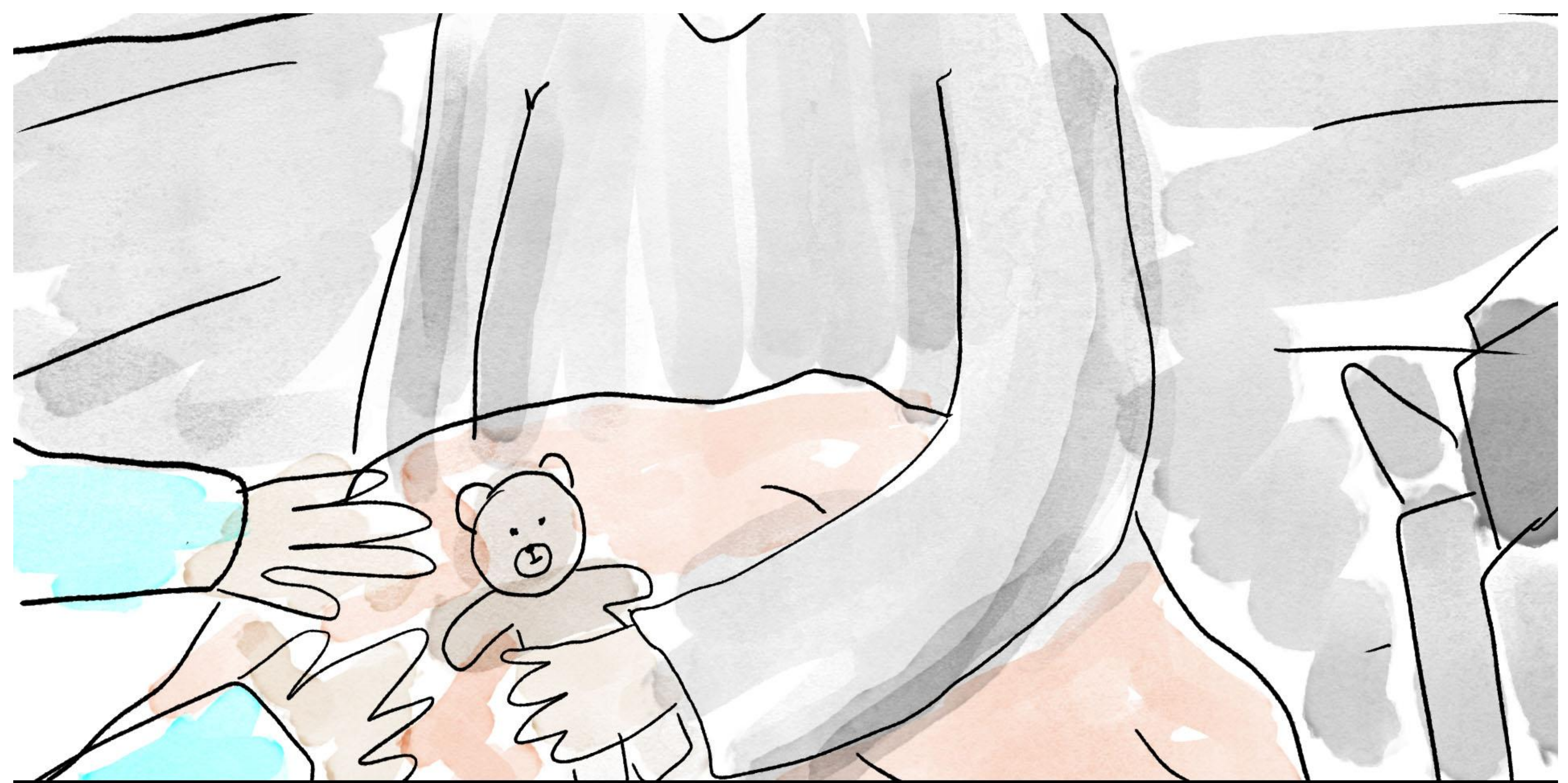
We see a car in a parking lot on a cold winter's evening.



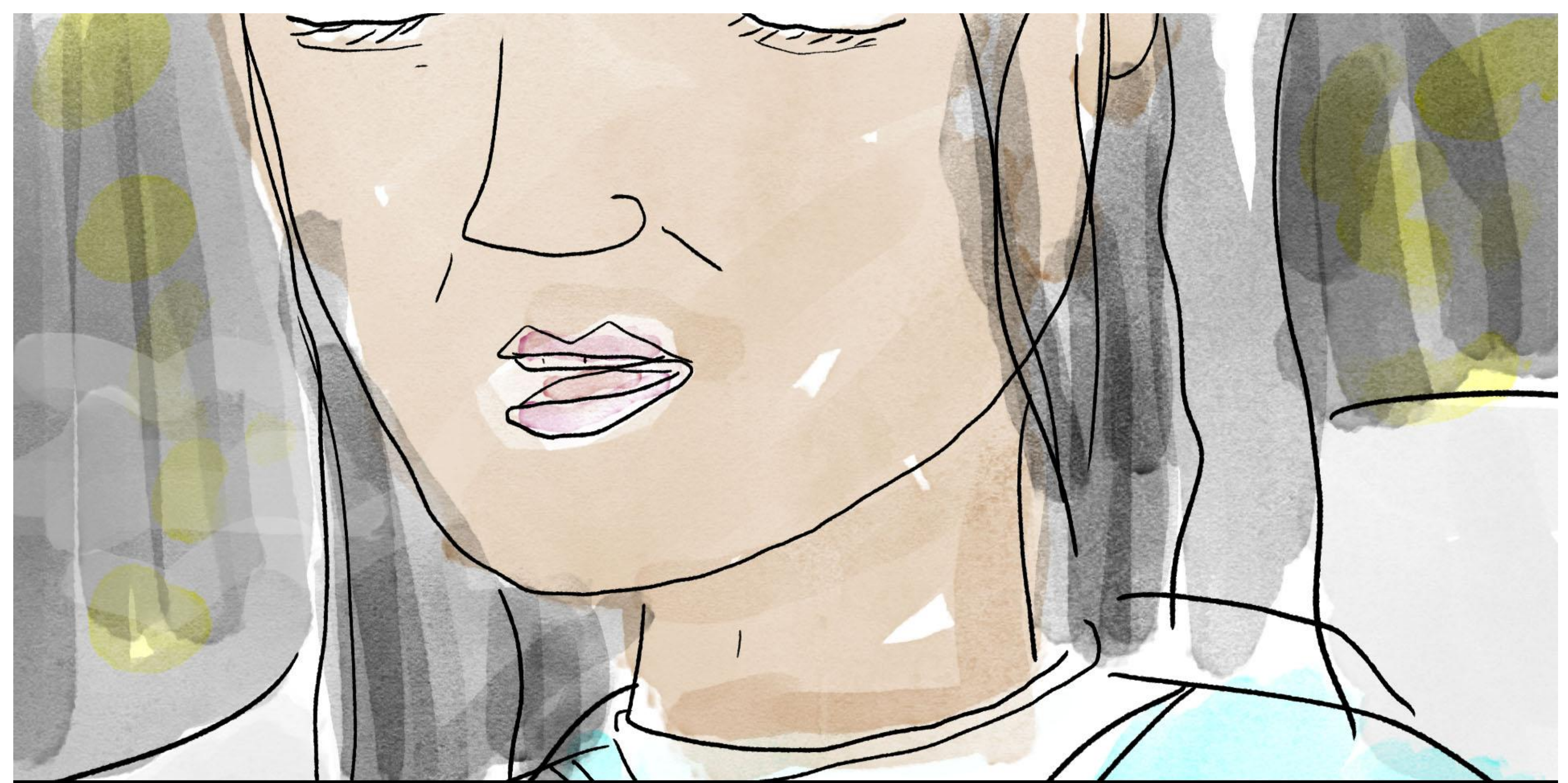

“...for Christmas”

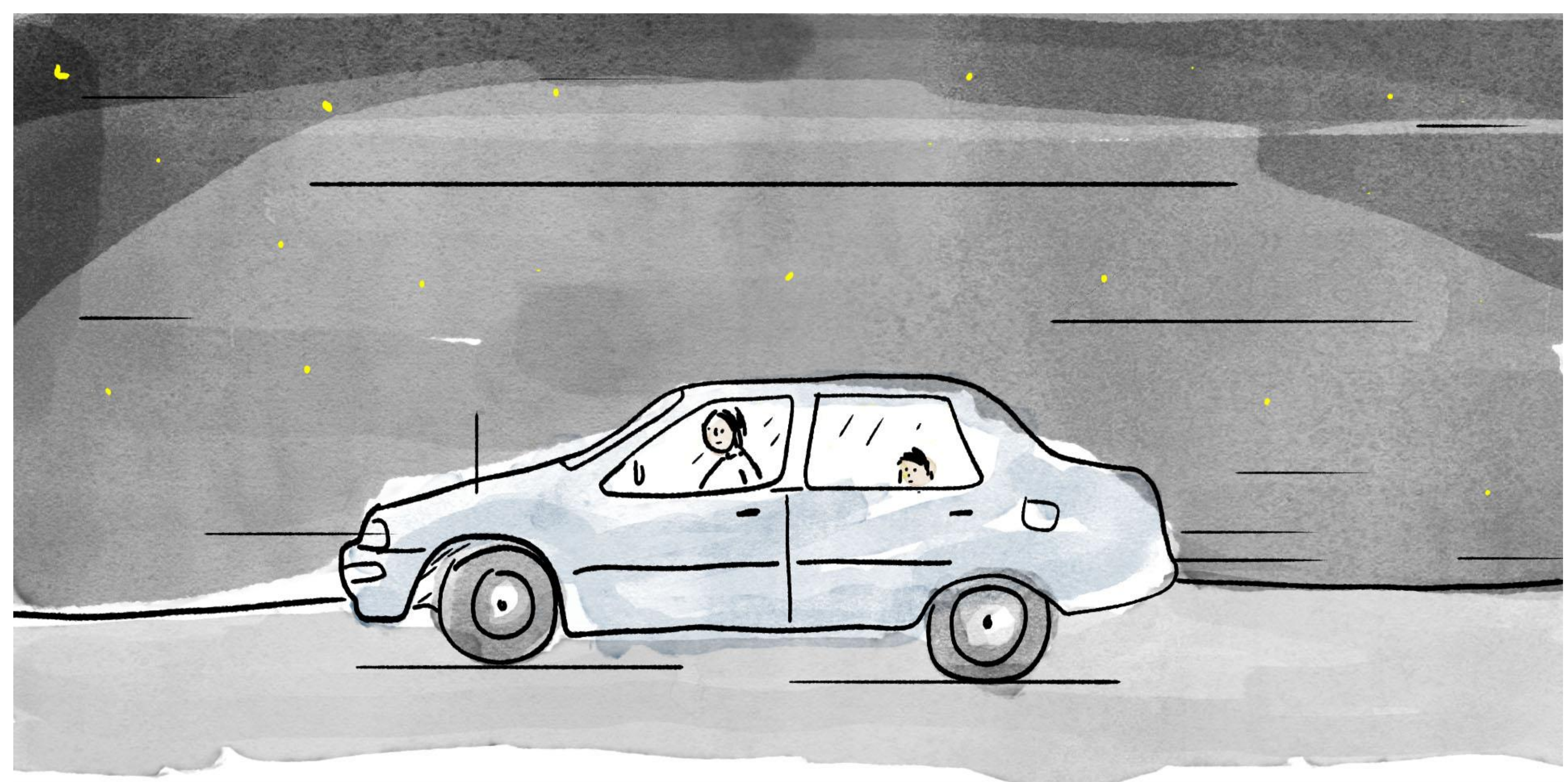


We see a shot of her face as her lips sing the Christmas melody, condensation is on her breath because it's cold outside.

“... for Christmas”



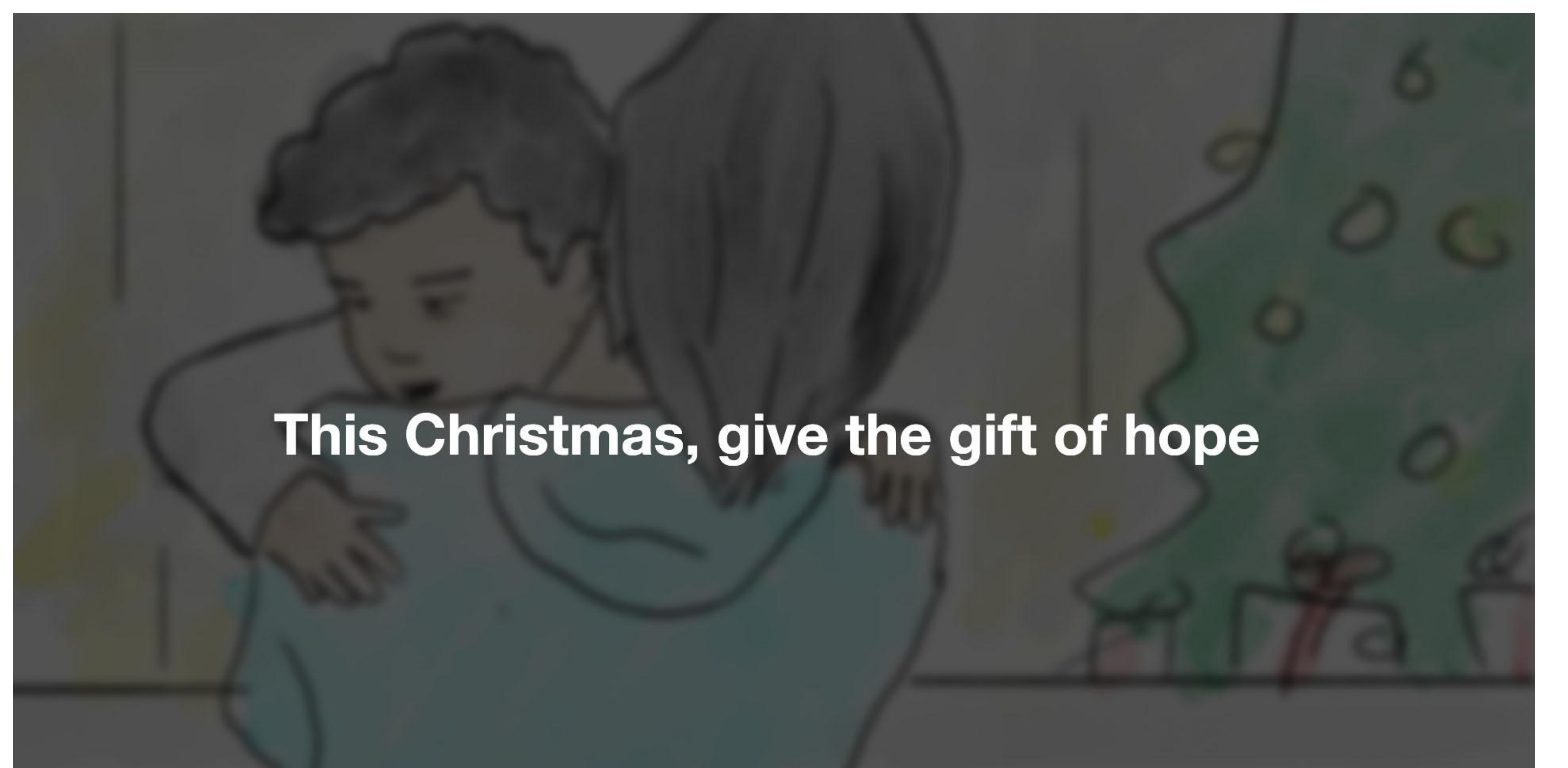
Near the end of the song we see them arrive at the mission.

another homeless person is asleep next to him



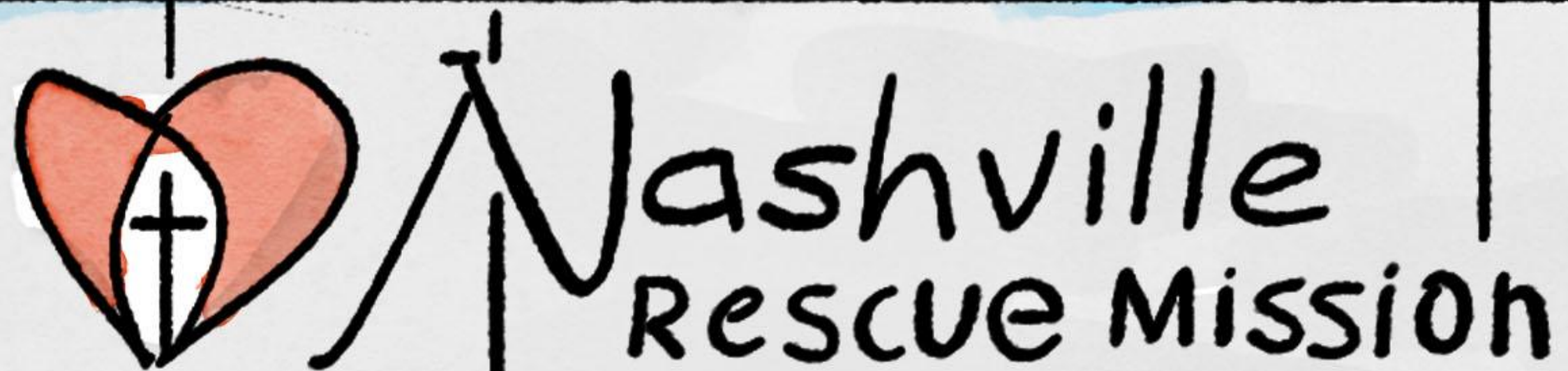
♪ It is well ♪

♪ it is well with my soul ♪

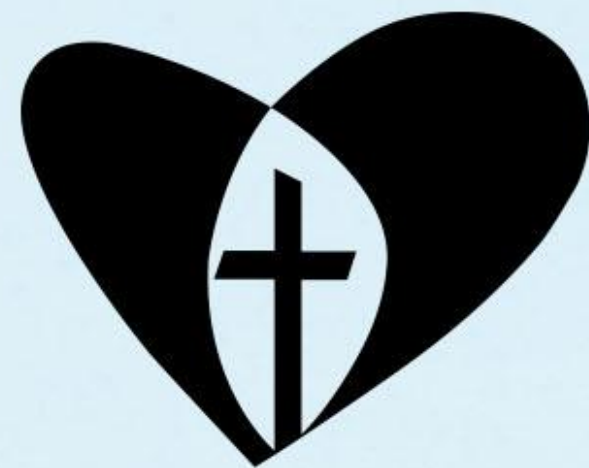


We pan to the blue morning sky above the mission and the title card is revealed
